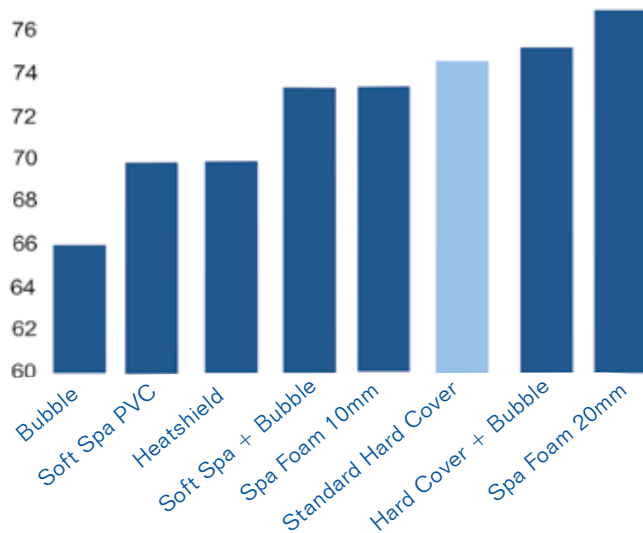
What's covering your spa?

Thermal Spa Foam

The best choice for heat retention

These thermal foam covers have been independently tested, and *proven* to out-perform many hard covers when it comes to heat retention.

Made with high-quality closed-cell foam, these covers will not absorb moisture and become waterlogged.

Easily trimmed to shape with scissors or a knife, this foam offers excellent insulative properties, preventing 100% of water loss due to evaporation.

Spa Foam comes in individual sheets which fit together and sit on the water. 10mm sheets (pictured above) are supplied with hinges for extra rigidity, but these are not necessary for the 20mm sheets.

Spa Tex

For a more 'finished' appearance, Spa Tex gives the benefits of 20mm Thermal foam upholstered in a high quality polypropylene mesh. Fully edged with black trim, Spa Tex is custom-made to measure, and folds neatly for easy storage.

Spa Tex is available in a choice of Black, Blue, Green, Tan (pictured right) and Grey.

Spa Soft Covers

Lightweight but durable, it's easy to see why these soft, fleece-filled PVC covers are so popular. They are a great alternative to expensive hard covers - particularly when used in conjunction with a floating cover. Fully reversible, these covers are grey on one side and brown the other with a black edge trim - simply flip to suit your preferred colour scheme.

To stop rainwater pooling on top, each cover is supplied with an inflatable bladder to hold it out of the water. Covers also feature child-resistant, lockable clips on all sides.

Sizes and shapes to suit most portable spas

With options for an adjustable fit, Spa Soft covers suit square and rectangular shaped spas.



Leafstop for Portable Spas

These practical, lightweight polypropylene mesh covers are an economical way to keep leaves and debris out of an uncovered swim spa.

They are also ideal to use over the top of Thermal Spa Foam or other floating cover to protect it from leaves, debris and sun damage.

Lets water in, but keeps leaves out

Leafstop covers are made from a high-tech, blended micro-mesh fabric that allows rain water in, but keeps leaves out.

The Leafstop edge is fitted with eyelets and a stretch bungee cord, allowing the cover to fit over the top of the spa - a bit like a big shower cap!
