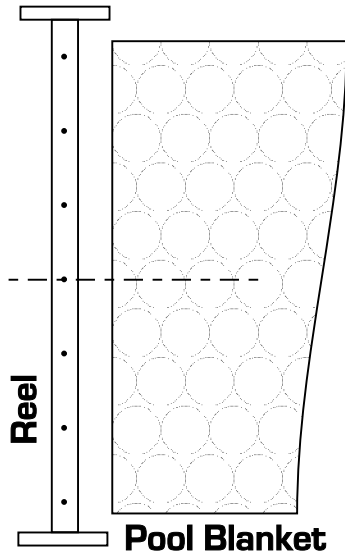


# Cord and Eyelet Kit

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Cord & Eyelets are used to attach a solar blanket to a reel. If you do not have a reel, you do not need this kit. You should however, consider buying a reel - they make using and storing a blanket much easier.

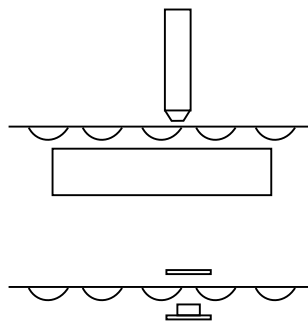


### Step 1

Before you attach the blanket to the Reel using the Cord and Eyelets, the Blanket must be trimmed to the size of the pool. Refer to your Pool Blanket instructions for details on trimming to size, or visit [www.abgal.com.au](http://www.abgal.com.au) and watch the video.

### Step 2

The Reel should sit as close to the Pool water as possible and on some Pools with curved ends, should sit over the pool to reduce any drag of the Blanket against the Pool coping. Position the tube of your Reel perpendicular to the rolling direction of your blanket. This is important so the blanket will roll straight. Centre the Reel with the centre of the main body of the Blanket.

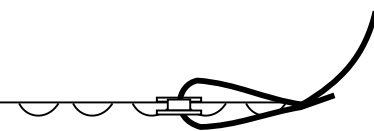


### Step 3

With the Reel and Blanket in position, use a punch or other tool to make a 10mm (3/8") hole 50mm (2") in from the edge of the Blanket and in line with screws in the tube of the Reel.

### Step 4

Locate the hole in the Blanket, place the eyelet in the hole, place the other half of the eyelet on top and press firmly together until you hear a "snap" and the eyelet is joined together.



### Step 5

Tie the Cord through each Eyelet and measure back to the tube of the Reel. Cut the Cord about 300mm (12") longer than this distance so you have some adjustment. Repeat this for each Eyelet.

### Step 6

Check the position of the Blanket and attach all Cords to the Reel making sure there is even tension on each one. The cords should still be long enough to allow the Blanket to lay flat on the Pool surface. If after attaching the blanket to your Reel, roll the Blanket up 2 or 3 times to check it is aligned with the Reel. If the blanket does not roll evenly, correct it by checking and adjusting the position of the Reel and the length of the individual cords.

### Step 7

Always make sure your pool blanket is covered with a protective overcover when it is stored on your reel. If you have any further questions about attaching the pool blanket to your reel, please contact your local supplier.
